As part of The Wharf (Holdings) Limited's continuing efforts in promoting public interest in arts and culture, "The Wharf Hong Kong Secondary School Art Competition" has been held annually since 2011. Entries of exceptional quality across 18 districts in Hong Kong are received every year.

In addition to the Competition, "The Wharf Art Scholarship Scheme" has been in place since 2012 to finance students selected from amongst the Competition's top 18 winners in undertaking a bachelor degree programme in creative art in a local or overseas tertiary institution of their own choice. Over the past 4 years, 11 students have been awarded scholarships to study art, architecture and design in renowned tertiary institutions, including Central Saint Martins, University of the Arts London; Architectural Association, School of Architecture in London; Goldsmiths, University of London; University of Bath in the United Kingdom; School of the Art Institute of Chicago; Curtin University in Perth, Australia; Guangzhou Academy of Fine Arts; Hong Kong Polytechnic University; Hong Kong Baptist University and SCAD Hong Kong.

The new edition of the Competition is now calling for entries! All full-time secondary school students in Hong Kong are welcome to submit entries. **Submission deadline is 3rd February 2017 (Friday) at 6pm.** For students who are interested in creative art, please do not miss this opportunity!
